

FALL TABLE CENTERPIECE

Supplies needed:

- Glass
- Maple leaves
- Tea light
- Decorative pick
- Decorative mesh
- Twisted rope
- Spray paint
- Pam spray
- Foil
- Glue gun
- Small tree branch
- Scissors
- Pumpkin garland
- 6-inch clay pot

Estimated cost: \$30

Time: Two hours

- Spray the tree branches outside, let dry.
- Spray Pam on a 6" x 12" piece of foil. With glue gun--and plenty of glue--start at top, with your glue gun, straight line down, keep adding to look like a waterfall.
- Starting at the base of the clay pot, glue the rope up to the top. About 2/3 of the pot will have the rope.
- Turn pot upside down and glue glass, add the waterfall inside the glass, decorate the small tree branches with leaves, mesh material.
- Glue a leaf to tea light and one tea light with extra leaves.
